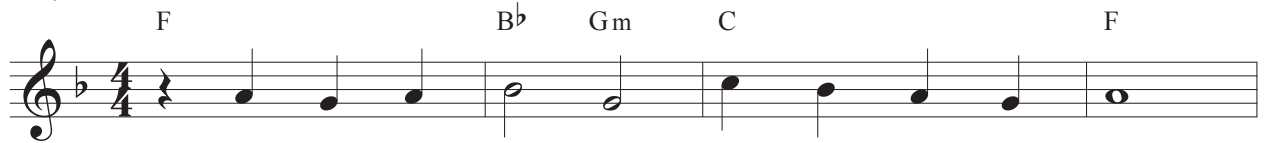


# The Lord Is King, Enrobed In Majesty

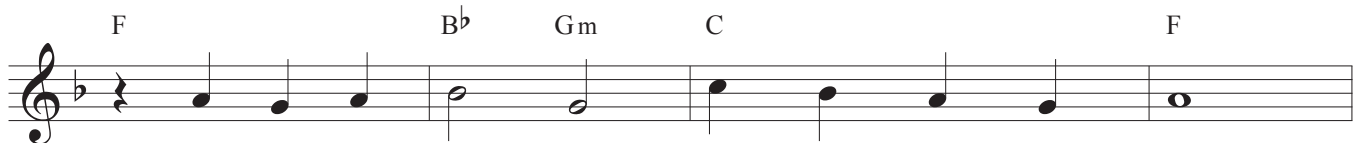
